## **Meeting Minutes**

- II. Presentation by Dr. Shekar Shetty

Tatum Sheets, Sister Cities intern, introduced Dr. Shekar Shetty. Dr. Shetty is an Associate Professor of Finance in the Perdue School of Business at SU. During the spring semester of 2009, he taught at Tallinn University of Technology, in Tallinn, Estonia, as a Fulbright Scholar. He talked about Tallinn, Tartu, and Estonia in general.

IV. Fall Reception for International SU Students & Faculty
