b. Tartu, Estonia

Mary attended an event in Annapolis on April 18 that MEEC hosted. Milt Davis, Bob Agee, city officials, and the Director of the U. S. Investment and Trade at the Embassy of Estonia in Washington, D. C. attended. Bob Agee spoke about a landfill problem in Annapolis. He solved this problem from the bottom up rather than top down. He put together a 14-page RFP with only three goals listed and instructed the end user to be creative in supplying a solution. The landfill was transformed into a revenue-producing 20-acre solar farm. She also reported that at SCI's international conference in Dubai the topic will be climate change. They will discuss global solutions and how cities and other local entities can contribute.

c. Salinas, Ecuador
